Collections

The Collection Committee met and twenty-one items were ordered for June. The last of the order has arrived and we are still putting new books into the system. Our next collection meeting is set for Tuesday, July 12.

Directors Report

We had 471 patrons during the month of June. Of those patrons, 20 used the computers, and 13 meetings/events were held with a total of 153 people. Two hundred ninety-eight people used the wireless. Four new library cards were issued. Items from Lake Pleasant to other Libraries totaled 142. Items transferred from MVLS/SALS to us totaled 81. Four hundred seventy-eight items were checked out and circulated 578 times.
