## **Collections**

The Collection committee met and 23 items were ordered for September. The last of the order has arrived and we are still putting new books into the system. Our next collection meeting is set for November 8, 2022.

## **Directors Report**

We had 530 patrons during October. Of those patrons, 34 used the computers, and 13 meetings/events were held with 174 people. Three hundred thirty-five people used the wireless. Three new library cards were issued. Items from Lake Pleasant to other libraries totaled 168. Items transferred from MVLS/SALS to us totaled 107. Six hundred sixty-seven items were checked out and circulated 754 times.

Three people attended a Medicare Session here on Saturday, October 21. I schedule this yearly, and we usually have at least three people attend. Quilt Drafting started on October 24 and has seven quilters attending. This class is scheduled for six weeks.

One hundred thirty-three people attended the celebration here.

We received a revised copy of Robert's Rules of Order from SALS. If you are interested in borrowing it, please let me know. This new item will be entered into Polaris by November 30.

Pam and I traveled to Richards, Chester, Johnsburg, Indian Lake, and Long Lake Libraries on October 28. All the libraries had excellent children's rooms. The most impressive was Chester Town and Long Lake. Both had lean-tos and murals painted in those rooms, and Long Lake had an Outhouse just steps from their lean-to.

An eContent Task Force meeting was held on October 28. The recommendation to the Director's Council is to pay by usage. We will continue looking at grants and other funding models as a group. We will receive an invoice for \$76.72 to cover eContent till December 31.
